



Trinity Facilities Use Agreement and Hold Harmless Agreement

I Affirm That:

- a. I understand that Trinity does not allow its facilities to be used in a way that contradicts its faith, or by persons or groups holding beliefs that contradict Trinity’s *Statement of Faith*.
- b. *To the best of my knowledge*, the purpose for which I am requesting use of Trinity’s facilities will not contradict the church’s faith, and I commit to promptly disclose any potential conflict of which I am aware or become aware to Trinity staff.

c. I understand that, upon approval of my *Trinity Facilities Agreement Form*, I may need to provide:

- i. A Security Deposit in the amount of \$

- ii. A Certificate of Insurance for at least \$1,000,000.00 of coverage. This Agreement must indicate that the person or group using Trinity’s facilities has listed Trinity CRC as an “additional insured” on the person or group’s policy with respect to the use of Trinity’s facilities, and /or;

d. I understand that Trinity does not allow its facilities to be generally available to the public, and that my use of these facilities is subject to the Council’s approval, which is conditioned in part on my agreement to the requirements in the *Trinity Facilities Use Policy*, a copy of which I have read and understand.

e. I understand that I will be responsible for any damages to Trinity facilities resulting from this proposed use.

f. I agree to hold harmless, indemnify, and defend Owner (including Owner’s agents, employees, and representatives) from any and all liability for injury or damage including, but not limited to, bodily injury, personal injury, emotional injury, or property damage which may result from any person using the above described premises, its entrances and exits, and surrounding areas, for User’s purposes, regardless of whether such injury or damage results from the negligence of the Owner (including Owner’s agents, employees, and representatives) or otherwise.



g. Trinity believes disputes are to be worked out between parties without recourse to the courts.¹ Accordingly, Users of the facilities agree to attempt resolution of any disputes through Christian mediation.
